

Community Dementia Link (CDL) – Course Length 12 hours.

Course Description: The training is a bespoke education package designed to support teachers and support staff, in primary, secondary, and Post 16 educational settings in Gloucestershire, to deliver any aspect of work linked to the **Intergenerational Dementia Project**.

It will be delivered by two experienced NHS practitioners, who work as part of The Dementia Training and Education Strategy for Gloucestershire.

Delegates have to attend all three sessions in order to gain the status of Community Dementia Link.

The course aims to equip teachers and support staff to deliver learning opportunities/activities that: -

- Improve long term health and wellbeing
- Di-stigmatise Dementia and understand ageing
- Help to build Dementia-friendly communities
- Learn about the science of Dementia and how the 5 Ways to Wellbeing can aid prevention
- Increase knowledge and understanding of Dementia in community and family settings
