

### Developing Sensory Interventions and Therapeutic Spaces for C&YP with SEMH and C&I Needs

#### Course Overview

C&YP with sensory processing difficulties may find everyday experiences unpleasant or even overwhelming. This can leave school staff disempowered and anxious, especially when the child or young person does not respond to their attempts to regulate. This full day workshop aims to provide up-to-date information in relation to emotional regulation, sensory processing, sensory interventions and therapeutic spaces.

#### Outcomes

- :: We will cover the psychological theories behind self-regulation and sensory integration in relation to children and young people with a range of sensory processing difficulties, including those with autism, attachment difficulties and with a background of trauma.
- :: We will also give participants a chance to understand the practical application of these theories through their own experiences of sensory stimuli.
