Sex and the Law – What are your and your organisation’s responsibilities in regards to safeguarding? This module looks at the most up to date laws in relation to sex and relationships, including CSE, revenge porn and sexting.

Sex in a digital world – How does the availability of apps and porn via modern technology impact on sexual behaviour and relationships today? What role does the media play in sexual identity?

Let’s talk about sex – Talking about sex makes it a less taboo subject. Know your gonorrhoea from your syphilis, testing options and barriers to testing.

Healthy relationships – What is a healthy relationship? How do we recognise when it’s unhealthy? How do we support people with self esteem and confidence?

Teenage pregnancy – Do you see young women becoming pregnant when they might not mean to? Would you like to help prevent unplanned teenage conceptions?

Condoms and contraception – Explores condom negotiation, correct condom use, long lasting contraception and influences such as culture and religion.
