

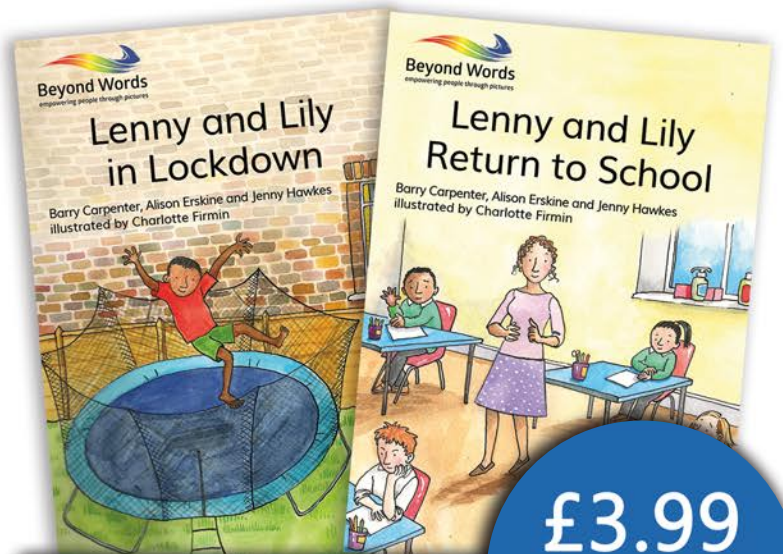
# Wordless stories to support children returning to school
