

Mental Health Champions Award- Portfolio ideas

When submitting for your Mental Health Champions Award, you will need to provide evidence to support your application. This can be in a physical or electronic form and should demonstrate the wide range of provision for emotional health and wellbeing in your school.

Below is a list of evidence you could include. However, this is not exhaustive and not everything will be relevant. Please do include anything you would like to share and celebrate to show how you have been working towards this award in your setting.

- Data/work/photos to analyse and show the impact of the interventions.
- Planning to show coverage and timetabling of the RHSE/PSHE curriculum.
- Examples of children's work.
- Photos/ other evidence of events, fundraising activities, visitors, assemblies etc.
- Pupil voice or outcomes of any other school community questionnaires/surveys.
- Information about pastoral support in your setting.
- Overview of other wellbeing provision across all areas.
- Any relevant policies.

There is no set way of presenting your evidence. However, some schools like to set out their evidence linked to each of the areas in the review. Please get in touch with your lead teacher if you have any queries.
