Preventing Infections

There are currently increased levels of measles circulating. MMR vaccination is the best form of defense against measles and has the added advantage of also preventing rubella and mumps. It is never too late to catch up. The MMR vaccine is free on the NHS, whatever your age. You can protect your community, **both staff and children**, by encouraging uptake of the MMR vaccine which can be accessed via GP surgeries.

Spiral Curriculum

There has been much debate about RSE recently with some even calling for the introduction of age restrictions for RSE content. Brook are guided by young people and young people often tell us that their RSE lessons were 'too little too late'. So how do you know what to teach and when?

Following a spiral curriculum approach helps to map your RSE curriculum to the different stages of adolescence that young people navigate.

This means introducing a topic and then returning to it year after year and building on it with more detail as a young person develops and grows. Ideally, we would suggest doing this through regular, dedicated lessons.


