PPE is equipment that will protect the user against health or safety risks at work. It can include items such as safety helmets, gloves and eye protection.	Face time time spent in face-to- face contact with someone. During lockdown, many people have used devices to maintain face to face contact with relatives.	Thermometer An instrument for measuring and indicating temperature. These have been helpful to test whether people have a high temperature, associated with COVID.	Key workers are people whose jobs are vital to public health and safety during the coronavirus lockdown.	Hand sanitizer is a liquid, gel, or foam generally used to decrease infectious agents on the hands. During lockdown, hand sanitizer has been useful to reduce the spread of germs.
Hand washing also known as hand hygiene, is the act of cleaning one's hands to remove soil, grease, microorganisms, or other unwanted substances.	Closure An act or process of closing something, especially an institution, thoroughfare, or frontier, or of being closed.	Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by a newly discovered coronavirus.	Face mask a protective mask covering the nose and mouth or nose and eyes	Gloves are pieces of clothing which cover your hands and wrists.
