HOW DO I START?

Once we receive your completed application we'll request references and arrange an informal interview and any training. We'll also be in touch about a DBS if the role requires one.

Mentoring is all about walking alongside someone on their journey; helping them to open up, work through challenges and look ahead to a brighter future.

Mentors meet mentees face to face over a coffee or on a walk or remotely over the phone.

You'll need to be able to commit to meeting your mentee once a week for an hour or two and attend monthly volunteer support sessions.

We'll provide you with full initial training over five weekday evenings and one Saturday Morning.

And after training you will have the opportunity to choose which area of our support services you would like to volunteer in.





YOUTHWORK (18+)

Youthwork volunteers support staff to deliver fun, exciting sessions while keeping young people safe.

It helps if you know your way around a pool table



or an Xbox but if not we're sure the young people will be happy to bring you up to speed

Volunteers should expect to be able to commit to 2 to 3 hours per session.
