WHAT IS EXPLOITATION?

Child Exploitation is the act of using a child under 18 for profit, labour, sexual gratification, or some other personal or financial advantage.

TYPES OF DOMESTIC ABUSE:

- Physical
- Emotional and psychological
- Financial
- Sexual.



SIGNS OF EXPLOITATION

RECOGNISE THE SIGNS FOR YOU AND YOUR FRIENDS:

- Hanging out with new, older friends
- New belongings – phone, clothes, jewellery
- Skipping school
- Staying away from home overnight
- Reported missing to Police
- Starts dressing differently
- Starts drinking alcohol and/or taking drugs
- Spending more time on social media
- Unexplained injuries
- Change in mood or behaviour
- Being forced to carry drugs leave the house.

ADVICE



ALL FORMS OF CHILD EXPLOITATION ARE CRIMINAL OFFENCES:

- Sexual
- Criminal
- Trafficking
- Forced labour.

Report to the Police if you think you know someone is being exploited or you are being exploited yourself.

It may be hard to recognise if you are being exploited.

Look out for friends. Tell a trusted adult if you think they may be at risk of exploitation.
